

Taize (tay-zay) is a form of a Christian prayer originating from the ecumenical Christian community of Taize, France. One song of Taize you may be familiar with is the chant, "Jesus, remember me, when you come into your kingdom", which is sung repetitively.



Some are homeless (living along the riverbanks or local motels as shelters) others come between work hours to stretch a pay check and a third are retired living on their Social Security check.
