## Catherine's Cupboard

CATHERINE'S CUPBOARD has been serving our community for the past 20+ years, it's open the 1st & 3rd Tuesday each month from 5 till 7 (or until all are served). We serve anyone who comes, asking only for ID, if they have any. As members of SOUTHERN TIER FOOD BANK, we purchase at wholesale (or less), providing basic dry or canned goods, fresh fruit and vegetables, dairy, and frozen meats. We try to provide 5 days of meals and include personal care items also. We operate on 100% donations or **grants**. Our location at the parish center means we have most overhead costs covered. However, we serve over 1200 people, requiring a budget of close to \$50,000 a year. PLEASE tell anyone you know who is feeling food insecure to stop in. If you would like to donate food items, they can be left at parish center or food barrel in church foyer. Monetary donations can be mailed to our parish office or via the online giving tab at stfrancisbing.org



#### Formation for Ministry Invitation

Formation for Ministry also offers learning opportunities for adult Catholics who seeks to learn more about their faith for their own personal enrichment. #### **Easter Sunday: Justice Challenge**

The Good News of the Resurrection is proclaimed this week in our Scripture readings. And this good news is meant for everyone. Jesus was and is a universal savior. One of the insights we receive on Easter Sunday comes from Acts 10. Peter, struggling to be faithful to the teachings of Jesus, announces that he has learned that "God shows no partiality". This helped to shape many decisions made by the early Church leaders—and it should form our decisions as well. Your challenge this week is examine how well you live by God's example. Do you personally and/or as a household show partiality to particular groups of people based on their race, religion, economic level, occupation? Do you exclude any groups on the same basis? If your reflection reveals partiality to some and exclusion of others, make a commitment to change. Identify three steps you can take so that in the future you can in all sincerity say that you, like God, show no partiality.


#### **SPRING CLEAN OUT:**
