Dear Bishop Cunningham,

Introduce yourself. What do you like to do, are you a good scholar, athlete, listener? Tell something about your family and your background that the Bishop may find interesting or unique.

Request the sacrament. Give several reasons why you would like to be confirmed. Perhaps tell the Bishop if anything has affected you and your relationship with Jesus.

Explain how you have prepared for the sacrament. It is important that you tell about the specific parts of your preparation: your prayer life, your celebration of the other sacraments (Eucharist/Reconciliation), your service for others exercised at home and within the parish and in your community....

Talk about a moment when it fit together. This probably did not have happened in class but may have been something that happened at school or at a family gathering when you really understood what it means to be *Christ* to the world. When you accepted Jesus' invitation to go out and serve.

Tell how you will continue to carry out your service to God and others through the power of the Spirit. Tell how you plan to make your Confirmation in the faith real and alive in the future.

End your letter with your regards, and sign the letter.
